2011 – 2012 REVISED FEE SCHEDULE

CATEGORIES: CMIS has instituted a Standard tuition rate with reduced rates for eligible* families.

- **Standard:** Applies to all current CMIS families **previously categorized as Sponsored**, as well as all new students who will begin in the 2011-2012 academic year, not in one of the following categories:
- **Discount:** Applies to **all current Non-Sponsored CMIS families** prior to the 2011-2012 academic year, and to new students whose parents work with regional or local **non-profit or non-governmental organizations (NGO's)**; both Christian and non-Christian.
- **Self-Funded Missionary:** Applies to all current CMIS families who meet the criteria, as well as all new students **whose parents actively serve as self-funded Christian missionaries**. (Any qualified missionaries who are not self-funded would be considered "Discounted" for accounting purposes.)

*Eligibility for either reduced rate category requires proof of affiliation with an appropriate organization.

Enrollment fees are due upon notification of acceptance to CMIS. This amount is fully refundable if the school application is withdrawn prior to June 1, 2011. A 50% refund will be given prior to July 1, 2011, with no refund payable after that date.

Capital Improvement and Alumni fees apply to all new FAMILIES, as well as current CMIS families in the Standard Category.

Learning Support: Available as needed on an evaluation and/or referral basis. There are no additional fees for students receiving Learning Support.

Textbooks: Supplied at no additional charge.

Please note: 50% of the Total Tuition is due at the beginning of each semester. The Capital Improvement and Alumni Association fees are due in full at the beginning of the first semester.

RETURNING STUDENT POLICY:

- ✓ A withdrawing student who plans to return to CMIS at some time in the future may reserve their space by leaving a **10,000 baht deposit** on file with the Finance Office.
- ✓ *This non-refundable deposit is to be paid before leaving CMIS in order to guarantee the returning student's place upon return. **Any student who withdraws and does NOT pay the re-enrollment deposit before leaving will be classified as a new student for tuition and fee purposes, and will be classified in the Standard Category unless otherwise eligible for a reduced rate.***
- ✓ A CMIS application form, along with supporting documents, must be completed when a student applies for re-enrollment to Chiang Mai International School. The 3,000 baht non-refundable application fee is due and payable when an application is submitted.
- ✓ For students who return after **less than one full academic year**, the 10,000 baht **deposit** will be credited toward their first semester tuition upon return. The Returning Student fee is NOT required for those who return after less than one full academic year.
- ✓ Students returning from an overseas home leave or temporary relocation after an absence of **one or more** academic years will be considered Re-enrolling Students, and the 10,000 baht **fee** will apply. The deposit, which was left on file with the Finance Office, will be applied to pay the Returning Student fee.

STUDENT WITHDRAWALS: A written Request for Withdrawal form must be submitted to the CMIS office at least two weeks prior to a child's last day of school. Tuition refunds will be calculated according to the withdrawal date stated on the withdrawal form. Parents should come to the school office on the last day of school for their child to obtain all reports. Parents who wish to have a student's report mailed will be charged a fee for postage and handling – 350 baht for overseas and 75 baht for domestic.

TUITION FEE REFUND POLICY:

- Tuition fees and ESL fees will be charged on a prorated basis for enrollment of less than a full year by applying the following formula: 2% per day of the current semester tuition fees for the first forty-nine days of enrollment; and Full semester fees for enrollment of fifty days or more. Capital Improvement and Alumni Association fees are non-refundable.
- **Acceptance and entrance constitute a contract to pay the entire year's fees as specified on the fee schedule.** There is no reduction or refund for absence or dismissal, unless covered by the tuition refund policy, as stated above.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

1. The Capital Improvement fee, Alumni Association fee, and 50% of the Total Tuition fees must be paid in full within 10 calendar days from the first day of the first semester. The remaining 50% of the Total Tuition fees are due within 10 calendar days from the first day of the second semester.
2. Late enrollment, for students who transfer in to CMIS after the semester has begun, requires that all fees for that semester be paid in full at the time of enrollment.

OVERDUE PAYMENTS: Interest at the rate of 1.5% per month will be charged for all late payments. Late fees will be assessed based on the tuition payment deadline each semester. CMIS reserves the right to exclude students from classes when fee payments are overdue.

METHOD OF PAYMENT: Payments should be made in baht, by cashier's check, or by bank draft; payable to the order of "Chiang Mai International School". Bank transfers are acceptable, but a deposit slip must be submitted to CMIS with the student's name and grade attached. **The CMIS account is "Siam Commercial Bank (McCormick Hospital Sub-branch), Chiang Mai, Thailand, Savings Account Number 731-2-00008-1. The SWIFT Code is SICOTHBK".** CMIS is not responsible for wire transfer fees. Personal checks drawn on banks within the Chiang Mai District are acceptable. If a check is returned due to insufficient funds, a **1,000 baht** charge will be added to the invoice, and the invoice will be immediately payable in cash. Regrettably, we are unable to accept payments by credit card.

Payments are to be made at the CMIS Finance Office during school days from 08:00 – 15:30.

NOTE: *CMIS sets annual fees based on its projected income and expenses. The projected Fee Schedule for the 2012-2013 & 2013-2014 academic years are available upon request. In the event of severe financial stress, the School Board reserves the right to revise the fees at any time during this projected period.*
